
Tahoe Forest Health System Community survey tracking report, June 2007 Priorities for bond measure expenditures

The three projects/improvements that generated the most support for the proposed measure were:

- The current Cancer Care Center is not large enough to meet the demand for treatment. This
 measure will expand the Center so that cancer patients have convenient access to treatment, close to home.
- Without this measure, our hospital will lose maternity care, and may lose women's health services and pediatrics. Women and children would have to travel out of our community for medical care. This measure will keep these services available in our community.
- The Hospital's Emergency Room is over 25 years old and is too small to accommodate the over 15,000 patients who are treated in the Emergency Room each year. During peak times, emergency patients must wait several hours for care and some are treated in the hallway. This measure will expand the Emergency Room to ensure quick access to lifesaving emergency medical care.
